Docents are volunteer teachers who provide learning experiences for Art visitors in the form of discussions and tours. They also help to facilitate art sales. Docents help enhance the visitor experience and provide a vital link between art and the visitors. A background in art is not required, just a passion for life-long learning.

You will have the opportunity to assist with pre-fair activities such as judging and artwork delivery, as well as working in the building while the State Fair is open. Don't feel ready? All docents will receive credentials for entry into the fair and parking on their shift days. Other incentives include season admission and parking when you volunteer for five (5) or more shifts, opportunities to get daily & season admission for your spouse or partner, and free monorail rides for the 2023 State Fair & Food Festival!

- Volunteer for 4 pre-fair shifts of 3 hours or more ..... Admission Ticket & Monorail Ride
