He went on and talked about "Rustic Charm", the Candy Selfie Experience, Wild Things and the CA. Hight Speed Rail exhibit. Mr. Cranford reviewed the Programs in A/B and moved on to the Expo Buildings. Cranford and CEO Martinez went on to explain the Cannabis Center. The Cannabis competition is the only State recognized competition that is data driven by Santa Cruz Labs. Last year the Board approved expanding the competition to provide a location for consumption. Lot 25 is the furthest away from kids' activities and will be open in the afternoon until

9 p.m. most days. Director DiMare asked that it be noted that the previous board voted against the sale of cannabis on the fairgrounds during State Fair. Mr. Cranford talked about the CA High-Speed Rail Exhibit in Expo Bldg. 5. You'll be able to experience an interactive journey and tour through the bustling stations and get an exclusive glimpse inside the new state-of-theart trains.

i. Horse Racing

Kyle Brown, Box Office Manager, reviewed the staff report with the board. He mentioned May 4th will be the Kentucky Derby and our Master Food & Beverage Partner is hosting a Derby Party. As we head into State Fair there is a proposed post time for Thoroughbred Horse Racing. The suggested post time is 5:00 p.m. That will ensure that the races are done by 9:00 p.m., allowing sufficient time for fireworks at 10:00 p.m. Vanning and stabling will return with the backstretch opening on July 12, 2024.

INTRODUCTION

Attached for your review is an update of the Statement of Financial Activities for Quarter 1 and the Aging of Accounts Receivable and Payable Reports.

Annual Audit Progress:

We have been in active communication with our independent auditors and are in the wrap-up audit process for fiscal year end 2020. Once the 2020 fiscal year audit has concluded, we will begin the 2021 fiscal year audit.

The independent auditor firm, Richardson, LLP, is contracted with a term of January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2024, with an option to extend for an additional two (2) one-year terms. Cal Expo has exercised its option to extend the agreement for one (1) additional year. The Board decided in 2021 to combine the audits for both 2020 and 2021 as a result of Cal Expo's transition from events to COVID emergency response.

Subject: X Games Year-Around Facility at Cal Expo

The X Games organization has reached out to us with this opportunity, expressing their interest in potentially hosting the event at Cal Expo.

X GAMES OVERVIEW

The X Games, established in 1995, have become the pinnacle of action sports competition, showcasing the world's best athletes in skateboarding, BMX, and Moto X. Conceived as a platform to bring action sports into the mainstream, the X Games offer a professional and widely broadcasted venue for extreme sports athletes. Since their inception, the X Games have expanded internationally, holding events in countries such as China, Japan, and Australia.

Over nearly three decades, the X Games have evolved into a global brand, influencing sports, music, fashion, and youth culture. Today, the X Games are recognized as the premier brand in action sports, known for their high-energy competitions and significant impact on youth culture. The brand thrives on a vibrant mix of competition, culture, and community, engaging over 600 million fans globally.

POTENTIAL PARTNERSHIP

The X Games team has identified Cal Expo as a potential host site for their annual summer event, with the intention of leveraging its strategic location and facilities to deliver a world-class experience for both athletes and fans.

The proposed engagement includes:

- Temporary Annual Event: Hosting the X Games summer event for two consecutive years.
- **Permanent Facility**: Exploring the development of a year-round facility dedicated to action sports and related activities.

The X Games team is drawn to Cal Expo due to its ample space, central location, and potential for customization to meet the specific needs of the event. This partnership is seen as an opportunity to elevate the X Games experience while bringing significant economic and cultural benefits to the Sacramento region. Steve Dooner has been the primary liaison in the discussions with the X Games team.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Board of Directors authorize the CEO and/or his designee to engage in discussions with relevant parties regarding the X Games, focusing on establishing a two-year temporary hosting arrangement and negotiating terms for making Cal Expo their permanent venue.

Subject: Federal Bills H.R.1787 and S.4040

Butler Amusements, our long-standing carnival partner, has requested that we discuss and support for the following federal bills: H.R.1787 and S.4040.

BUTLER AMUSEMENTS PARTNERSHIP OVERVIEW

Butler Amusements, a family-owned and operated company, is the largest carnival company in the western United States. They provide carnival services for over 100 events annually, including 35 state and county fairs. Their operations include over 125 amusement rides across seven states: California, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Nevada, Arizona, and Texas. Since 2009, the California Exposition & State Fair has partnered with Butler Amusements to provide all midway services during the annual State Fair. Cal Expo has enjoyed 15 years of growth and positive experiences with Butler Amusements.

H.R.1787 AND S.4040

The proposed federal bills, H.R.1787 (the CARE Act) and S.4040 (the RIDE Act), aim to address the significant labor shortages faced by the mobile entertainment industry, including carnivals, fairs, and circuses. These industries have seen a 50% reduction in the number of operating companies between 2016 and 2023, primarily due to difficulties in obtaining sufficient temporary workers through the H-2B visa program. These companion bills seek to rectify this by allowing mobile entertainment employers to utilize the P non-immigrant visa classification, currently reserved for certain athletes. entertainers, and their essential support staff. By clarifying that mobile entertainment employees qualify as essential support personnel under the P-visa program, the bills aim to provide a more reliable and adequate labor supply for this industry.

The California Exposition & California State Fair should consider supporting bills H.R.1787 and S.4040 as they directly benefit the mobile entertainment industry, which is crucial for the success of state and county fairs. By alleviating worker shortages and ensuring that carnivals can operate effectively, these bills would help sustain the

revenue and attendance levels that fairs rely on. Additionally, the bills include provisions to ensure that the use of P-visas does not negatively impact American workers, maintaining fair wages and working conditions. Supporting this legislation aligns with the interests of the State Fair in maintaining a vibrant and successful fairground experience for attendees.

These bills are also being supported by the International Association of Fairs & Expositions (IAFE), which represents and promotes fairs and expositions around the world. The Outdoor Amusement Business Association (OABA), which advocates for the interests of the outdoor amusement industry, is also in support. Additionally, the National Independent Concessionaires Association (NICA), which supports and represents independent concessionaires who work at fairs and festivals, backs these bills.

RECOMMENDATION

The staff recommends that the Board of Directors approve the California Exposition & California State Fair's support of Federal Bills H.R. 1787 and S. 4040.
