

COMPETITION OVERVIEW



The California Skateboarding Competition and exhibition is recognized as one of the Golden State's new and exciting shows.



You are invited to enter the California State Fair's skateboarding competition for California skaters of all ages. We wish you success in this competition and hope you will join us for sharing the best moments of summer at the 2025 California State Fair on July 11-27.

Who Can Enter & Entry Fee

California residents who have reached 5 years of age as of January 1, 2025.

\$25.00 per entry

Online entries must be paid by Visa or Mastercard. Entry fees are non-refundable. A maximum of 30 entrants will be accepted per class.

Entry Deadline

All entries must be registered online and all entry fees paid at <https://calexpos.fairwire.com/> by 11:59 pm, June 13, 2025.

Late Entries will not be accepted.

How to Enter

1. Review all information in this guide, taking note of entry deadlines, competition dates and directions, entry requirements and rules, and which class you will enter.
2. Internet browser must be up to date. Check the browser to make sure Flash add-on is enabled.

Attention Mac Users: Please use Internet Explorer, Chrome, or Mozilla Firefox when entering.

RULES & REQUIREMENTS

Rules

1. Practice Sessions

120 minutes of shared practice time will be provided to all competitors before their qualifiers and the championship.

2. Qualifier Rounds (Friday & Saturday)

- Participants will be split into two groups:
 - 1st Round Qualifiers compete on Friday
 - 2nd Round Qualifiers compete on Saturday
- Each skater will receive five (5) runs of 45 seconds each.
- Best single-run score is retained, and the other four scores are discarded.
- The top 15 competitors from each round qualifiers will advance to the Championship Finals on Sunday.

3. Championship Finals (Sunday)

- Each finalist receives five (5) runs of 45 seconds.
- The **best single-run score** is kept, and the other four scores are discarded.
- Final rankings are determined by the highest-scoring single run.

4. Makes v.s. Bails

- The **Head Judge** is the final decision-maker in determining whether a trick is considered a **Make (landed)** or a **Bail (failed)**.
- **Definition of a Make:** A trick where the skater **lands with control** and continues rolling or repositions naturally.
- **Definition of a Bail:** Any trick where the skater **loses control, falls, or dismounts** from the skateboard without a clean landing.

5. Tie-Breakers

- If two or more skaters tie after final scoring, the tie is broken by comparing each skater's **second-best run score**.
- If the tie still remains, a **judging panel vote** will determine the winner.

- The Head Judge will have the final determining vote if necessary.

6. Conduct & Sportsmanship

- **Fair Play:** No intentional interference with other competitors.
- **Respect for Officials & Staff:** Judges' decisions are final.
- **Substance Policy:** No drugs or alcohol permitted at the competition.
- **Course Etiquette:** Skaters must **leave the course promptly** after their run.

7. Dispute Resolution

- Judges' decisions are final.
- Any disputes must be **filed in writing within 30 minutes** after results are announced.

8. Rule Adjustments

Day-of Competition Rule Changes: These rules are subject to **modification or adjustment** at the discretion of the **Head Judge or event organizers** to accommodate competition conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Requirements

Equipment & Safety

- **Skateboards:** Must be in **safe working condition** with no major cracks or broken parts.
- **Protective Gear:** Helmets, knee pads, elbow pads, and wrist guards are **required**.
- **Clothing & Footwear:** Closed-toe skate shoes **required**. No offensive or inappropriate imagery on clothing or boards.
- **Medical Staff:** EMT personnel will be available on-site for **immediate medical assistance**.

Age Verification

If discrepancies arise regarding an athlete's class qualification, they must present an acceptable age verification document (Driver's License, Birth Certificate, etc.).

DIVISIONS & CLASSES

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per entry.

Division 100 - Golden Bear Classic

Class 1 - 5-18 Years of Age

Class 2 - 18-34 Years of Age

Class 3 - 35 & Over Years of Age

Class 4 - Open Class - All Ages 5 & Up

Notes & Special Rules for Division 100:

- a. **Class 1-3:** No professionally sponsored riders receiving financial compensation (gear sponsorships allowed).
- b. **Class 4:** No restrictions on sponsorships or professional status.



JUDGING

JUDGING PANEL

- A 5-judge panel will evaluate each run.
- Judges are selected based on experience and skateboarding expertise.

SCORING CRITERIA

- **Difficulty** – Complexity of tricks attempted and landed.
- **Execution** – Stability, control, and cleanliness of landing.
- **Flow & Style** – Smooth transitions, creativity, and consistency.
- **Use of Obstacles** – Variety and effective use of the skate course.
- **Overall Impression** – General impact of the run.

SCORING CALCULATION

- Each judge will score a run on a **scale from 0 to 10**.
- **Highest and lowest scores are dropped.**
- **Best single-run score** is retained, and the other four scores are discarded.
- The **best single-run score** from a skater determines their ranking.
